Product Description:

Mononucleosomes assembled from recombinant human histones expressed in *E. coli* (two each of histones H2A, H2B, H3 and H4; accession numbers: H2A-P04908; H2B-O60814; H3.1-P68431; H4-P62805) wrapped by 147 base pairs of 601 positioning sequence DNA. Histone H3 (created by a proprietary synthetic method) contains acetyl-lysine at position 23. The nucleosome is the basic subunit of chromatin. The 147 bp 601 sequence, identified by Lowary and Widom, has high affinity for histone octamers and is useful for nucleosome assembly. The DNA contains a 5' biotin-TEG group.

Formulation:

H3K23ac dNuc (27.3 μ g protein weight, 50 μ g total weight) in 43.9 μ L of 10 mM Tris HCl, pH 7.5, 25 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA, 2 mM DTT, 20% glycerol. Molarity = 5.69 μ M. MW = 199,943.3 Da.

Storage and Stability:


Stable for six months at -80°C from date of receipt. For best results, aliquot and avoid multiple freeze/thaws.


Application Notes:

H3K23ac dNuc is highly purified and suitable for a variety of applications, including use as a substrate in enzymatic assays or for effector protein binding experiments.






Western Blot Data: Western Analysis of Nucleosome, Recombinant Human, H3K23ac. Top Panel: Unmodified H3 (Lane 1) and H3K23ac containing nucleosomes (Lane 2) were probed with an anti-H3K23ac antibody and analyzed via ECL readout. 
