# Nucleosome, Recombinant Human, H3K36ac dNuc, Biotinylated

Mononucleosomes assembled from recombinant human histones expressed in E. coli (two each of histones H2A, H2B, H3 and H4; accession numbers: H2A-P04908; H2B-O60814; H3.1-P68431; H4-P62805) wrapped by 147 base pairs of 601 positioning sequence DNA. Histone H3 (created by a proprietary synthetic method) contains acetylated lysine at position 36. The nucleosome is the basic subunit of chromatin. The 147 bp 601 sequence, identified by Lowary and Widom [1], has high affinity for histone octamers and is useful for nucleosome assembly. The DNA contains a 5' biotin-TEG group.

### Formulation:

H3K36ac dNuc (27.3  $\mu$ g protein weight, 50  $\mu$ g DNA + protein) in 45.5  $\mu$ L of 10 mM Tris HCl pH 7.5, 25 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA, 2 mM DTT, 20% glycerol. Molarity = 5.5  $\mu$ M. MW = 199,943.5 Da.

## Storage and Stability:

Stable for six months at -80°C from date of receipt. For best results, aliquot and avoid multiple freeze/thaws.

## **Application Notes:**

H3K36ac dNuc is highly purified and suitable for a variety of applications, including use as a substrate in enzymatic assays or for effector protein binding experiments.






Western Blot Data: Western Analysis of H3K36ac dNuc. Top Panel: Unmodified nucleosomes (EpiCypher 16-0006; Lane 1) and H3K36ac nucleosomes (Lane 2) were probed with an anti-H3K36ac antibody and analyzed via ECL readout. Only the H3K36ac sample produced a detectable signal. Bottom Panel: Detail Coomassie stained gel showing unmodified nucleosomes (Lane 1) and H3K36ac nucleosomes (Lane 2).




**Mass Spec Data:** Synthetic H3K36ac histone analyzed by high resolution mass spectrometry. Expected mass = 15,313.9 Da. Determined mass = 15,314.49 Da.

**Protein Gel Data:** Coomassie stained PAGE gel of proteins in H3K36ac dNuc (1  $\mu$ g) demonstrates the purity of histones in the preparation. Sizes of molecular weight markers and positions of the core histones (H2A, H2B, H3K36ac, and H4) are indicated.



**DNA Gel Data:** H3K36ac dNuc resolved via native PAGE gel and stained with ethidium bromide to visualize DNA. **Lane 1:** Free DNA (EpiCypher 18-0005; 100 ng). **Lane 2:** Intact H3K36ac nucleosomes (400 ng).

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
